CARE AND MAINTENANCE

DAY TO DAY CLEANING



1. BRUSH OR VACUUM

Brush or vacuum the tapestry well to remove surface dirt and sand.



4. ABSORPTION

Allow the cleaning solution to penetrate the rope.



2. WATER AND SOAP

Use of a cleaning solution with water and neutral soap.



5. RINSE

Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue.



3. BRUSHING

Use of a soft brush for cleaning so as not to damage the rope causing filaments to come out.



6. DRY

Allow to air dry in a horizontal position. Turn the carpet over to dry both sides.

STAIN CLEANING



1. WATER AND SOAP

Use a spray bottle that contains mild soap and water and apply it to the stain on the carpet.



2. BRUSHING

Apply the solution to the stain by lightly rubbing the area with a very soft sponge or brush.



4. GENTLY DRY

Press lightly the rope on the tapestry with a sponge or a soft, clean cloth to remove excess of water and moisture.



3. RINSE

Rinse well to remove all soap residue.



5. DRY

Allow to air dry. Repeat steps 3 and 4 until all the detergent residue is removed.

MOULD AND MILDEW STAINS



1. SOLUTION

Prepare a solution of a cup of hydrogen peroxide and a quarter of a cup of mild soap for 3.8 litres of clean water.



2. SPRAYING

Spray over the entire area and wait 15 minutes for the solution to penetrate the fibre.



3. CLEANING

Clean the entire area with a sponge, clean cloth or soft brush.



4. RINSE

Rinse well to remove all soap residue.



5. DRY

Allow to air dry.

PROFESSIONAL CLEANING

When evaluating the services of a professional company, you should always ask about the company's experience with outdoor hand-tufting tapestries and knowledge of the cleaning and reconditioning requirements of this type of rug.

OTHER RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended to clean the entire surface of the rug to avoid stains and water marks along it. We advise turning the rug 180° at regular intervals to prevent marks from furniture positioned over it. It is advisable to keep the rug in a sheltered place when it is not being used. For greater durability of the rug / floor we strongly recommend the purchase and use of an underlay.
